<b>Body</b>	<p>The medium-sized body combines the elegance of the Siamese with the roundness of the Burmese. The body is of medium length and well muscled.</p> <p>The legs are of medium length, the paws are medium-sized and oval.</p> <p>The tail is strong at the base and tapers to a slightly rounded tip.</p>																												
<b>Head</b>	<p>The head is wedge-shaped, with gently rounded contours, a slightly convex profile and high cheek bones. When viewed from the front, the head forms an equilateral triangle.</p> <p>The muzzle is prominent and rounded and <b>well defined</b>, but without a pinch.</p> <p>The chin is firm.</p>																												
<b>Ears</b>	<p>The slightly forward tilted ears are large and end in slightly rounded tips.</p> <p>They are set wide apart on the head, pointing slightly outwards to continue the outer lines of the wedge.</p>																												
<b>Eyes</b>	<p>The eyes are large. The upper eyelid is almond-shaped, the lower rounded. <b>Coat</b>	<p>The coat is medium short, fine, silky and dense and firm lying to the body.</p>																												
<b>Colour varieties</b>	<p>The entire body is typically covered by a lustrous sheen.</p> <p>In all colours the lower part of the body is slightly lighter than the back. The body colour is clear, without any tabby stripes or markings.
